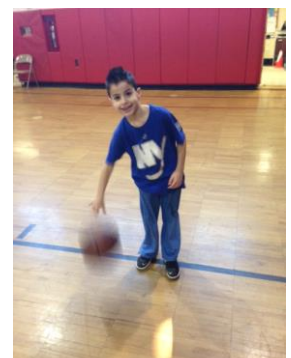


## Berry Hill Weekly Buzz
