#### 8. REVIEW OF THE MONTHLY REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

- The Board of Education and Superintendent congratulated 18 National Merit Scholarship Program 2014-15 semifinalists. With 18 semifinalists, it ties the Syosset record set two years ago.
- Newly appointed Syosset Athletic Director Drew Cronin delivered an introductory presentation to the Board, highlighting his philosophy and goals for the upcoming school year. Cronin spoke about the role of athletics in a student's overall educational experience and discussed a plan of action that included conducting exit interviews with coaches after a season concludes and offering professional development programs to help coaches improve their skills with student-athletes. Cronin also discussed the procedures in place for conflict resolution.
- Speed Cameras. Dr. Rogers updated the public on the speed cameras, which the County installed in front of Baylis Elementary School on Woodbury Road. County authorities told Dr. Rogers that the cameras will be in operation only Monday-Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and will not be in operation evenings or weekends, even if there is a school event taking place. (Note: The County has a Facebook page and website: https://www.facebook.com/NassauSchoolZoneSpeedSafetyCameraProgram http://www.nassaucountyny.gov/agencies/tpva/speed.html)
- Recycling Program. Update. Following up on previous Board meeting discussions, Dr.
   Rogers said our vending machine company would provide recycling receptacles at both

Middle Schools and the High School. The refund proceeds would go into the Student Activities fund. Dr. Rogers said the District is in talks with the vendor about when to begin the initiative.

- Grant Money. The Superintendent was pleased to announce that the district has received
  a \$13,000 grant through Nassau BOCES to be used for records management. This grant
  allows the district to digitize archived records and information that are currently on
  microfiche and are beginning to degrade.
- Security. Dr. Rogers also informed the public that the district has issued an RFP for an assessment of its security measures in light of a recent break-in over the summer months.
- Recreation Program. During the July Board of Education meeting, a member of the public asked if the Board could consider offering an on-line registration process for the recreation program. The current process involves registering in person and often involves a lengthy wait. Dr. Rogers announced that the district was able to serve all interested students for the current year, and therefore would offer an on-line registration system in addition to the in-person registration system. Should that system result in increased participation, the district has the capacity to accommodate it.
