

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back for the 2021-2022 school year! Please be advised that consistent with last year, meals for elementary and middle schools must be preordered. Should you wish to order meals for elementary and middle school students for the first week of school (September 1 - 3), the deadline to place your order is Wednesday, August 25, at 12:00 midnight.

The USDA has extended the provision of free meals (breakfast and lunch) to ALL students on days that school is in session. All students will be eligible for one breakfast and one lunch meal at no cost each day that school is in session, though meals for elementary and middle schools must be preordered.

Meals for high school students do not need to be preordered. Students will be served a limited-menu in a grab-and-go style as well as selected entrees.

Middle school students, and parents of elementary students, must pre-order meals through [Infinite Campus](#):

- Log on to Infinite Campus and select "School Store" on the left
- Click on the school, and select "Categories" (at the bottom of the screen)
- Select Breakfast or Lunch ordering menus to begin ordering
- Place no more than 20 items in your cart and then submit your order. Please note that separate orders should be placed for each student and that multiple orders can be placed for each student, if necessary.

PLEASE NOTE: Additional lunches and lunch a la carte items such as snacks and bottled water are NOT part of the free meal program, and therefore, student accounts will be charged for those items. To enhance hygiene, no cash will be accepted for meals in any locations. Online payments may be made by establishing an account on [MySchoolBucks](#).

Also please note that the food-service industry is currently facing supply-chain challenges directly related to labor shortages, limited production, and other ongoing disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Aramark is working proactively to address these challenges, though menu substitutions may be necessary at times.

Please note that USDA program for weekend and holiday meals ends on Friday, August 27.
