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Immunization Requirements for Students in Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5

Dear Parent/Guardian,

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

Documentation of the required immunizations must be received before September 19, 2023 to avoid exclusion from school effective September 20, 2023.

Required Immunizations for Students Entering Kindergarten & Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	4 doses or 3 if the 3rd dose at 4 years of age or older
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5 doses or 4 doses if the 4th dose is given at 4 years of age or older or 3 doses if series started at age 7 or older
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2 doses
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses

Please send proof of immunization, as stated below, to the school nurse where your child will be attending:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases. For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.
