APPLICATION for Level V and VI, All-State, and Harp NYSSMA SOLO AND ENSEMBLE FESTIVAL Syosset High School May 6 & 7, 2022

The New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA) sponsors a festival each spring in which students have the opportunity to perform solos and small ensembles (duets, trios, etc.) for an impartial adjudication. Judges, most of whom are chosen from outside the area, hear each student play a graded selection from the NYSSMA manual, prescribed scales and a short sight-reading selection (8 measures). Students are then given a written report with comments on their performance and a grade. Grades range from A+ through D- on Levels V and VI and are scored on a 100 point scale. In the case of a serious problem with the performance or a serious infraction of the festival rules, a student may not receive a grade. Levels of difficulty range as follows:

- Levels I - very easy - elementary
- II - easy - advanced elementary, middle school
- III - medium - middle school
- IV - medium difficult - advanced middle school, high school
- V - difficult - advanced high school
- VI - very difficult - only for the most advanced soloists

NYSSMA festival grades provide a standard that is used for acceptance to all-county festivals, many music camps and can be included in college applications. The festivals also serve as the audition sites for the All-State band, chorus and orchestra (grades 10 and 11 only are eligible).

Students participating in the NYSSMA festival (and their parents) should be aware of the following: (More detailed information and preparation are available through our individual music teachers.)

1. The **2020** festival will be held at **Syosset High School on May 6 & 7.**
2. Audition times may be at any time from Friday afternoon through Saturday afternoon.
4. All solos must be listed in the current NYSSMA Manual. **Check this carefully with your school music teacher.** The current manual is **Vol. 32**. Private teachers do not always have the current manual. Double check with your child's music teacher at school to make sure your solo is listed.
5. **Two copies of the solo should be provided** (one for the student and one for the adjudicator). A piano part may be used as one copy (except for an All State Evaluation).
Photocopies are not permitted.

6. Check the NYSSMA Manual for specific regulations on scales, sight reading, etc. Be especially careful of requirements for percussion as All-State percussion has additional requirements. All Level V and VI solos will be given 15 minute audition times.
7. All-State students must audition on Level VI. Vocal All-State students must perform in the designated key and may not transpose.
8. All All-State auditions must be accompanied on piano or tape unless the piece is specifically written as “unaccompanied.”
9. All-State applicants must submit a NYSSMA All-State application form. (See your teacher).
11. Only students in grades 10 and 11 may audition for All-State.
12. Students will receive their grades from their teachers during the following week at school.
