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INTRODUCTION

The college selection process is one that should be both positive and productive. With the right tools and information, parents and students can meet the challenge of identifying colleges that are a good fit, academically and socially.

For students with learning differences, there is the additional consideration of providing the student with the necessary support to address his/her special needs.

This guide is designed to help students begin identifying colleges that offer programs and services for students with learning differences. Schools were included in this guide based on one or both of the following factors:

- The school is located in a geographic area frequently chosen by Syosset High School students.
- Syosset students have applied to the school in the recent past.

This does not preclude other schools providing these services.

Many factors must be taken into consideration when choosing a college. Students are encouraged to carefully explore all options by discussing plans with their guidance counselor and reaching additional resources, including the valuable ones listed in this guide. Above all, students should visit each college they are considering. Of utmost importance is meeting with the person in charge of the department through which services are offered. It can be easy to be swayed by well-meaning advice of others and promotional literature. However, it is only by experiencing a school's environment and meeting with members of its academic support community that one can effectively determine those colleges that meet his/her needs.

COLLEGE PLANNING GUIDE

FOR STUDENTS WITH LEARNING DIFFERENCES

All colleges and universities conduct programs to ensure equal access to all courses, services, and facilities for students with documented disabilities. Through assistance, advocacy, and reasonable accommodations, the disability services provide an accessible and supportive campus environment. All policies and procedures meet the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

As defined by the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, a qualified person with a disability means a person who meets the essential eligibility requirements of the academic program or service and is able to perform the essential requirements of the academic program or service, with or without reasonable accommodation. A person with a disability is one who a) has a physical or mental impairment which substantially limits one or more major life activities, b) has a record of such impairment, or c) is regarded as having such an impairment.

Accommodations for eligible students are available without fee at all colleges. Eligibility under these statutes is determined case-by-case based on documentation of a learning disability or ADD/ADHD. The disability must currently substantially limit a major life activity, including learning.

LAWS THAT PROTECT THE RIGHTS OF ADULTS WITH DISABILITIES

Title VI Civil Rights Act of 1964

Prohibits discrimination based on race, color, or national origin in all employment situations involving programs or activities aided by federal financing.

Title VII Civil Rights Act of 1964

Prohibits job discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex or national origin in all employment practices: hiring, firing, promotions, compensation, and in all other terms, conditions and benefits of employment, including vacations, pensions, and seniority.

Section 504 Rehabilitation Act of 1973

"No otherwise qualified handicapped individual in the United States shall, solely by reason of his/her handicap, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance...".

Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990

Extends universal civil rights protection to individuals with disabilities, covering public and private sector employment, public accommodations, transportation, and telephone communications.

Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Acts (ADAAA)

Effective January 1, 2009 – expands the interpretation of disability under the original Americans with Disabilities Act and protects school-age children and adults with disabilities from discrimination in employment, public, and privately-operated settings. The law applies to all public and most private schools and colleges, testing agencies, and licensing authorities. It also applies to state and local governments and to private employers with 15 or more employees.

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974

All students over the age of 18 are free to access their own student records, request changes to their student records, and “to have some control over the disclosure of personally identifiable information from these records.” Parents of children over the age of 18 are not permitted to access their child’s student records, as protected under FERPA.

Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) of 2004

Provides for special education and related services for children and young people with disabilities up their 22nd birthday. The IDEA provides a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) and for an Individualized Education Program (IEP) for eligible students.

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) of 2014

Reauthorizes and updates existing federal workforce development programs including the Rehabilitation Act, which provides for vocational rehabilitation (VR) services for people with disabilities.

Questions to Ask When Visiting Colleges

Once the general characteristics of appropriate colleges have been evaluated, five or six serious choices should be identified. The colleges must then be contacted, interviews arranged, and family visits planned. Campus tours and the opportunity to sit in on classes must be given particular attention, since it is extremely important for a student who has learning differences to personally judge the level of difficulty of the instruction, observe the interaction of the students, and gain for himself or herself a sense of the relationship between the students and the faculty.

The admissions interview may not answer all the questions regarding programs for students with learning differences. If it does not, the student and parents must seek out and meet with a member of the learning differences program staff. A list of questions based on family concerns and perhaps stimulated by a review of college catalogs and websites or discussions with high school guidance personnel, should be prepared prior to the visit. Questions might include the following:

- Is the program run by full-time trained Special Education professionals?
- What is the application process for students with differences?
- What services are available?
- What documentation is necessary for the specific program?
- Are there additional fees for services?
- How many students with learning differences are on campus?
- Who counsels students with need during registration, orientation, and course selection?
- How does the school address a specific need?
- How well do faculty members accept students with needs?
- Is remediation and/or support provided on a one-to-one basis? In a group? If in a group, how large is it?
- Are faculty and administrators aware of the needs of the students as well as their potential for success?
- Is outside tutoring available when necessary, and who does it – students or staff?
- Is tutoring automatic, or must the student request assistance?
- Are courses in study skills or writing skills offered?
- Do students with learning differences take regular courses?
- May students with special needs take a lighter load?
- Who should students contact if they have concerns during the academic year?
- How many students with learning differences have graduated from this program? In what fields?
- What have they done since graduation?

TIP: Try to meet with students in the program and ask questions
