#### **Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)**

- ESSA is a federal education law which specifies how states and schools can use federal grant money to support school district programs and students in need.
  - The law emphasizes <u>equity</u> in education for <u>all</u> students and expands measures for school accountability and student access.
  - ESSA promotes collaborative decision making with the various constituency groups within school districts in order to direct the allocated funds.
  - This public presentation is also required by law.
