Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)

- ESSA is a federal education law which specifies how states and schools can use federal grant money to support school district programs and students in need.
 - The law emphasizes equity in education for all students and expands measures for school accountability and student access.
 - ESSA promotes collaborative decision making with the various constituency groups within school districts in order to direct the allocated funds.
 - This public presentation is also required by law.

ESSA Title	Intended Purpose
Title I Part A	To support academic programs that provide all children with an opportunity to succeed. This funding is based upon the number of students from low-income families in our district.
Title II Part A	To support and improve the quality and effectiveness of teachers, principals, and school leaders, to further increase student achievement.
Title III Part A	To support language enhancement and academic achievement for our ENL Programs which support ELL students.
Title IV Part A	To support teaching, learning, and academic enrichment in order to provide a additional enhancement for our academic program.
Title V Part A	Low-Income Rural Education (Syosset is not eligible).
